Additionally, the program has had three program directors (Dr. Shirazi, followed by Dr. Greene, followed by Dr. Shirazi) in two years, before the entry of a single resident.

Resources/Toxicology Laboratory [II.D.2.c)]

Toxicology laboratory services with 24-hour availability must be organized and provided at the primary clinical site.

The program did not document compliance with the requirement. For example, 24-hour onsite availability was marked as "No" and turnaround times were marked as "N/A" for ethylene glycol levels. Although Tucson Medical Center's hyperbaric oxygen service is listed as a resource, it is not clear based on the provided information how fellows will receive the necessary experience. Tucson Medical Center is not indicated as a participating site in the PIF.
