Program Director Qualifications/Documented Experience

The information provided did not demonstrate compliance with the requirement that the program director should continue in his or her position for a length of time adequate to maintain continuity of leadership and program stability. Additionally, the program has had three program directors (Dr. Shirazi, followed by Dr. Greene, followed by Dr. Shirazi) in two years, before the entry of a single resident.

Toxicology laboratory services with 24-hour availability must be organized and provided at the primary clinical site.

The program did not document compliance with the requirement. For example, 24-hour on-site availability was marked as "No" and turnaround times were marked as "N/A" for ethylene glycol levels. Although Tucson Medical Center's hyperbaric oxygen service is listed as a resource, it is not clear based on the provided information how fellows will receive the necessary experience. Tucson Medical Center is not indicated as a participating site in the PIF.
