During its June 8, 2020 conference call, the American Veterinary Medical Association Council on Education received as information, the College's notification that letters of acceptance had been sent to the initial class. Based on progress made in implementing its plan and the admission of its first class, the Council voted to extend provisional accreditation to the University of Arizona College of Veterinary Medicine effective immediately.

As a reminder, the College is still required to submit biannual reports. The College's next biannual report is due July 15, 2020.
